


Stars In My Garden



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Stars in My Garden

Crib Quilt

Block size: 6 1/2" (6" finished)

Finished Size: 42" x 50"

This pattern is very simple to create and is a great way to use up some scraps while highlighting a special large-scale print... all at the same time!


All seams should be sewn with a **scant 1/4" seam allowance**, and all seams should be pressed to one side. Press after every seam you sew to ensure your blocks are accurate.

Materials and Yardage:

Yardage requirements based on 40" wide fabric.

Material:	Yardage:	Cutting Guide:
Yellow floral	3/4 yard	15 A
White	3/4 yard	60 B, 60 D
Scraps for stars	To total 1/2 yard	15 B, 60 D
Purple sashing	1 yard	71 C
Green setting squares	1/4 yard	42 B
Backing	1 1/2 yards (single piece at least 45" wide) -OR- 2 1/2 yards (pieced backing)	
Batting	Crib (45" x 60")	
Binding	1/2 yard	

Rotary Cutting Guide:




Measurements include a 1/4" seam allowance.


Note that this guide is only to provide a visual of what the pieces will look like once they are cut, they are not to be used as templates.

Assembly:

1) First, sew together a white “D” and a colored “D” to make a 2 1/2” square, sewing along the long side. Be careful when sewing and pressing a seam on the bias edge lest the fabric stretch. **Make 60 blocks.**




2) Assemble **15 stars** as shown. Your star should measure 6 1/2” x 6 1/2” when assembled.




3) Assemble 7 sashing rows (called Row X) out of 5 purple “C” pieces and 6 green “B” pieces.




4) Assemble 3 block rows (called Row Y) out of 6 purple “C” pieces, 3 star blocks and 2 “A” pieces.



5) Assemble 3 block rows (called Row Z) out of 6 purple “C” pieces, 2 star blocks and 3 “A” pieces.



6) Assemble the quilt top. Alternate between Rows Y and Z, putting a row X between each.



7) Piece the backing if necessary. Layer backing, batting and quilt top; baste; quilt as desired. Bind to finish.

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
